





knowledge to post graduate trainees and contribute to the social commitment of education of disease prevention of dreaded oral diseases among public.


Clinical research should be actively pursued among members and trainees which will benefit the surgical fraternity and must be intended towards goal of benefitting the society for better clinical out comes.

# INFLUENCE OF TECHNOLOGY IN TODAY'S PRACTICE OF MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY

Technology is influencing the practice of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery like never before. Invariably, it has led to better patient outcomes, enhanced patient safety but at the same time de-skilled the surgeon. The last bit can have a big influence in future training and education pathways.

After graduation, a surgeon needs to be constantly upgrading in terms of a sub specialty with further in training and education. Orthognathic surgery with Virtual surgery and Desktop printed surgical splints,



Cancer diagnostics radiation technology such as Proton & Boron therapy and navigation surgery are a few examples of such newer technology which have to be understood and mastered by today's Maxillofacial surgeon. More important is to also understand that every new technology may have it's own drawbacks and hence benchmark it to conventional therapy. Here I am reminded of the Physician's prayer "With contempt for everything old and too much zeal for anything new, good Lord, deliver us".

Digital technology is now considered the Fourth Industrial Revolution with fusion of biological, physical and digital sciences. Most changes have been seen in maxillofacial implantology, maxillofacial prosthetics, orthognathic surgery and oncology. Combining cone beam CT data with CAD/CAM technology and virtual planning allows one to plan prosthetically driven implant placement. This leads to better bio mechanics for the implant prosthesis, less morbidity for the patient and more predictability for the rehabilitation. We have all seen the

struggle and multiple surgical procedures needed for re-constructing the external ear. 3D printing technology of body parts is certainly a much better alternative.

NANO technology for better graft materials, drug delivery systems etc is also a big boon for basic research. Pooling of data and using artificial intelligence will facilitate grouping of patients and may throw up results and patterns that are normally not discernable otherwise.

The worrying thing for more experienced surgeons will be the de-skilling of several procedures which is similar to all the technological disruptions happening with so many things in everyday life. The power of artificial intelligence, data mining, software disruptions and desktop printing have changed the way practice is done now. We need to embrace this change and adapt if we have to be relevant in today's world.

Advanced technology may also re-define ethical boundaries, but as surgeons and care providers we should never forget the central purpose of "putting patients first".




